ORGANISERS



The Department of Statistics of Calcutta University was established in 1941 with Prof. P.C. Mahalanobis as the Head. It is the oldest Department in Asia that offers a post-graduate course in Statistics. It has nurtured and produced several eminent statisticians, who have received world-wide recognition. Over the years, it has established itself as one of the prime departments in India for dissipating knowledge in Statistics and related disciplines.

Calcutta Statistical Association is an international learned society, closely associated with the Department. It was established in 1945 with a view to promote activities related to Statistics and its allied fields. The Association publishes an internationally circulated journal, besides organising lectures, seminars, workshops and symposia. It also keeps a close liaison with the academic activities of the Department of Statistics in Universities, Colleges and other Institutes in West Bengal.

SYMPOSIUM

Following in the footsteps of the earlier eight symposia, held in 1991, 1994, 1997, 2000, 2003, 2006, 2009 and 2012, the Ninth International Triennial Calcutta Symposium will offer a common platform to statisticians engaged in research on theoretical and applied aspects of Statistics and Probability, to interact and exchange ideas. A fairly large number of eminent researchers from all over the world are expected to attend the Symposium. As in the past, a special session on Design of Experiments and Related Combinatorial Aspects will be organised in the memory of Late Prof. Raj Chandra Bose. There will also be a poster session for students and young researchers.

LANGUAGE

The official language of the Symposium will be English.

CALL FOR PAPERS AND POSTERS

Intending participants are requested to mail an extended abstract (in about 300 words) to papers.caltri9@gmail.com, latest by June 30, 2015. The preferred formats are PDF or DOC. The abstract should include a title, a few keywords, the name(s) of the author(s), affiliation(s) and full mailing address(es), including fax and e-mail ID(s). Decision on acceptance or otherwise will be communicated by July 31, 2015. The Power-Point presentations of accepted papers should be mailed to the above e-mail ID no later than December 20, 2015.

The contents of posters should be sent as a soft copy (PPT) by e-mail to posters.caltri9@gmail.com. The deadline for this submission is June, 2015. Decision on acceptance or otherwise will be intimated by July 31, 2015. The best three posters will receive cash awards. The posters should measure 4'x3' and should be sent to Dr. Dhiman Dutta, Joint Secretary, Calcutta Statistical Association, University of Calcutta, 35, Ballygunge Circular Road, Kolkata 700 019, latest by December 20, 2015.



PUBLICATION

As in the previous occasions, a special numbered volume of the journal "Calcutta Statistical Association Bulletin" will be published containing papers presented at the symposium and selected through a peer-reviewing process. The guest editors of the special volume are Professors Aditya Chatterjee and Anup Dewanji. Participants interested to publish their presentations in this volume should **send the full manuscript to the Convener, latest by January 31, 2016.**
